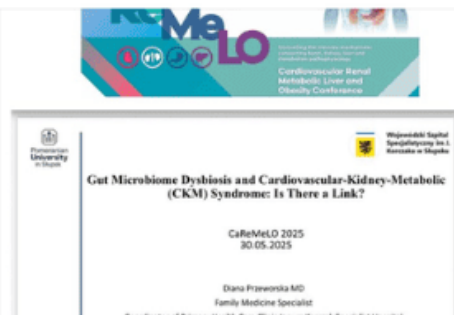

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CARDIO-RENAL-HEPATIC-METABOLIC (CRHM) SYNDROME Proposing an expanded framework

I'm very excited to share with you some perspectives on this issue, that is the main focus of current [#CaReMeLO2025 Cardiovascular, Renal, Metabolic, Liver and Obesity Conference](#)

Cardiometabolic (CM) diseases are a growing global health crisis, with conditions like obesity, type 2 diabetes (T2D), atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease (ASCVD), heart failure, chronic kidney disease (CKD), and metabolic dysfunction-associated steatotic liver disease (MASLD) increasingly recognized as interconnected rather than isolated.

Recent advances—including the American Heart Association's (AHA) 2023 proposal of the Cardiovascular-Kidney-Metabolic (CKM) syndrome—highlight the need for integrated care.

However, the liver's pivotal role has been underappreciated.

Key Points for Healthcare Professionals:

- 1 The traditional approach of managing CM diseases as separate entities is outdated; shared pathophysiological mechanisms and overlapping risk factors demand a holistic strategy.
- 2 MASLD is cause and consequence of metabolic dysfunction, closely linked to insulin resistance and obesity, and bidirectionally associated with CKM syndrome progression.
- 3 The new CRHM framework incorporates the liver alongside the heart, kidneys, and metabolic system, reflecting the true complexity of inter-organ dynamics in these patients.
- 4 The 2024 EASL-EASD-EASO guidelines include CM criteria in the diagnosis of MASLD, underlining its integration into the broader CM disease spectrum.
- 5 MASLD is highly prevalent among patients with other CM disorders and substantially increases the risk of CVD mortality, non-fatal CVD, coronary artery disease, heart failure, CKD, T2D, and other complications.
- 6 A new staging system for CRHM syndrome is proposed, ranging from no risk factors (Stage 0) to clinical CVD with end-stage organ disease (Stage IVb), to guide prevention, diagnosis, and management.
- 7 Advances in pharmacotherapy (e.g., SGLT2 inhibitors, GLP-1 receptor agonists, GIP/GLP-1 receptor agonists, finerenone) demonstrate benefits across multiple organ systems, supporting the need for an integrated management approach.

Recognizing and treating CM, renal, and hepatic conditions as a unified syndrome can improve patient outcomes by addressing the root causes and shared pathways of disease. This approach aligns with recent calls for a paradigm shift in obesity and metabolic disease management, as highlighted by The Lancet Diabetes & Endocrinology's 2025 commission on clinical obesity.

Healthcare professionals should adopt a comprehensive, multi-organ perspective in the prevention, diagnosis, and management of CM diseases, with special attention to the liver's role in disease progression and therapeutic targeting
